Wedding Guide *Helpful Hints to a Stress free Wedding Day*

1. Be sure that full payment is received no later than 7 days prior to the wedding day. (see the Payment Time line on the website or the 2008 Price List for more info)
2. Contact your florist and let them know what time photography will begin so that they can have all of your beautiful flowers and decorations in place before we start shooting.
3. Contact your wedding party and let them know the times that they will be needed for portraits. It is very important that the wedding party arrive on time so that we can get all the shots that are needed for a successful day.
4. Make sure everyone present during photography understands that we can't get great shots while they are walking in front of the camera or distracting those involved in the picture.
5. Please arrange with someone to have control of the lights before the ceremony. The lights might need to be adjusted to allow for better images. The lights can be reset for the ceremony when we have finished the pre-ceremony photography.
6. Please make a list of all groups you want photographed on your day. Include names also as this allows us to put names and faces together.
